**INTERIM ORDER ON MOTION FOR ORDER APPROVING SPECIFIED  
INFORMATION BLOCKING PROCEDURES AND PERMITTING TRADING IN  
DEBTORS' SECURITIES, BANK DEBT, PURCHASE OR SALE OF TRADE DEBT  
AND ISSUING ANALYST REPORTS UPON ESTABLISHMENT OF A SCREENING  
WALL EFFECTIVE JULY 25, 2003**


Upon the emergency motion (the "Motion") of the official committee of unsecured creditors of Mirant America Generation, LLC (the "MAGI Committee") appointed in the chapter 11 cases concerning the above-captioned debtors (collectively, the Debtors), which Motion has been joined in by the official committee of unsecured creditors of Mirant Corporation *et al.* (the "Mirant Committee", and, together with the MAGI Committee, the "Committee"), for the entry of an order pursuant to section 105(a) of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"), approving specified information blocking procedures and permitting trading in the Debtors' Securities (as defined in the Motion) or Bank Debt (as defined in the Motion), the purchase and sale of trade debt and issuing of analyst reports to the public or to the clients of the creditors whose representatives serve on the Committee in certain situations, and all exhibits attached thereto; the court hereby grants the relief requested on an interim basis, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion will be heard on August 6, 2003 at 1:30.
2. No entity, a representative of which sits on the Committee, shall be subject to

sanction or penalty in this court by reason of trading in Securities or Bank Debt of Debtors, provided such entity complies with the proposed rules set out in the Motion.
