**ORDER GRANTING TRANSWESTERN'S MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM STAY
WITH RESPECT TO FIRM GAS TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT**

Upon consideration of Transwestern's Motion For Relief From Stay With Respect To Firm Gas Transportation Contract (the "Motion");¹ and sufficient notice of the Motion having been given to parties in interest as required under the circumstances; and it appearing that no other or further notice of the Motion need to be given; and the Court having determined that good cause exists for granting the relief from stay requested in the Motion; and there having been no objections filed concerning the Motion; and the Debtors having advised the Court that they have no objection to the granting of this Order as set forth herein; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefore, it is hereby so

ORDERED that the relief requested in the Motion is granted, and it is further

ORDERED that the automatic stay, to the extent applicable, is hereby lifted, with respect to Transwestern Contract No. 26719, for the limited purpose of allowing Transwestern to apply Mirant's prepetition prepayment to pay prepetition charges, accrued during the period from July 1 to 14, 2003 in the amount of \$71,750; and it is further


ORDERED that the Debtors and Transwestern are authorized to take all necessary steps to implement the terms of this Order; and it is further

ORDERED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction regarding the implementation of this


Order.
