AS A PROSPECTIVE PROVIDER OF DEBTOR IN POSSESSION FINANCING**


Came before the Court for consideration the Request for Emergency and/or Expedited Consideration (the "Request") of the Emergency Motion of the Debtors for Entry of an Order Pursuant to Section 105(a) and Section 363(b) of the Bankruptcy Code Authorizing the Payment by the Debtors of Costs and Expenses Incurred by General Electric Capital Corporation, as a Prospective Provider of Debtor-in-Possession Financing (the "Motion") filed by Mirant Corporation and certain of its subsidiaries and affiliates (collectively, the "Debtors"). After considering the Request and the representations made therein, the Court finds that the Request has merit and should be granted. It is therefore, hereby

ORDERED that the Request is granted in full and in all respects; and it is further

ORDERED that the hearing on the Motion is set for August 27, 2003 at 9:00 a.m.; and it is further

ORDERED that the Debtors shall serve immediately a copy of this Order on all parties upon whom the Debtors served the Motion.
