REQUEST FOR EMERGENCY AND/OR EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION OF CERTAIN ASPECTS OF THE MOTION PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. §§ 105, 363(b) AND (f), AND 554 FOR APPROVAL (I) TO SELL CERTAIN ASSETS FREE AND CLEAR OF LIENS, CLAIMS, ENCUMBRANCES, AND INTERESTS; (II) OF PROCEDURES TO SELL CERTAIN MISCELLANEOUS ASSETS FREE AND CLEAR OF LIENS, CLAIMS, ENCUMBRANCES, AND INTERESTS; AND (III) OF PROCEDURES TO ABANDON AND DISPOSE OF ESTATE ASSETS THAT ARE BURDENSOME OR OF INCONSEQUENTIAL VALUE, AS TO SALE OF EXCESS FURNITURE ONLY

On September 10, 2003, Mirant Corporation and certain of its subsidiaries and affiliates (collectively, the “Debtors”) filed the Motion Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 105, 363(b) and (f), and 554 for Approval (I) to Sell Certain Assets Free and Clear of Liens, Claims, Encumbrances, and Interests; (II) of Procedures to Sell Certain Miscellaneous Assets Free and Clear of Liens, Claims, Encumbrances, and Interests; and (III) of Procedures to Abandon and Dispose of Estate Assets that are Burdensome or of Inconsequential Value (the “Motion”). The Debtors hereby request expedited and/or emergency consideration of the portion of the Motion relating to the sale of excess furniture only, as set out more fully herein.

The Debtors request that the Court hear the Motion as to the sale of excess furniture only on an emergency and/or expedited basis on September 24, 2003 at 10:30 a.m. The Debtors request expedited

consideration of the portion of the Motion wherein the Debtors' seek this Court's approval for Mirant Corporation ("Mirant") to sell certain excess furniture. The Debtors have requested October 1, 2003 as the hearing date for a hearing on the balance of the Motion, however Mirant is required to vacate the leased premises where the excess furniture is located by **September 30, 2003**. In other words, Mirant must sell the excess furniture and have such furniture removed from the leased premises **before** the regularly scheduled hearing date for the Motion of October 1, 2003. Mirant has located four potential purchasers of the excess furniture, and requests in the Motion the authority to sell the excess furniture to the bidder with the best, highest bid. Because of the deadline by which Mirant must vacate the leased space where the excess furniture currently is located, it is necessary for the Debtors to obtain a hearing date on shortened notice on the Motion as to the sale of the excess furniture. All of the other relief requested in the Motion will be heard on October 1, 2003.

Accordingly, the Debtors request that the Court enter an Order setting hearing on the Motion as to the sale of the excess furniture on September 24, 2003 at 10:30 a.m.
