**STIPULATION AND AGREED ORDER FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING
 ON MOTION OF PERRYVILLE ENERGY PARTNERS LLC FOR RELIEF
 FROM THE AUTOMATIC STAY TO INITIATE ARBITRATION (DOCKET 4641)**

On this day, the Court was presented with this Stipulation and Agreed Order for Continuance of Hearing on Motion of Perryville Energy Partners LLC for Relief from the Automatic Stay to Initiate Arbitration (Docket 4641). On July 14, 2004, Perryville Energy Partners, LLC filed its Motion of Perryville Energy Partners LLC for Relief from the Automatic Stay to Initiate Arbitration and Brief in Support Thereof (the "Motion for Relief"), which is set to be heard on August 11, 2004. Pursuant to the Agreed Order for Mediation and Abatement of Contested Matters Involving Perryville Energy Partners, LLC Pending Mediation (the "Mediation Order"), which was entered by this Court on July 28, 2004, the parties have agreed to mediate the Perryville Contested Matters (as defined in the Mediation Order) on or before August 13, 2004. Because the parties believe that it would be more economical to conduct the hearing on the Motion for Relief after the mediation has concluded, the parties request to continue the hearing on the Motion for Relief. Based on the foregoing, it is therefore

ORDERED that the hearing on the Motion for Relief is hereby continued to September 1, 2004 at 10:30 a.m. It is further

ORDERED that Perryville Energy Partners LLC shall have until August 25, 2004 to reply to any objections or responses to the Motion for Relief.




