STIPULATED ORDER EXTENDING DEADLINE BY WHICH TRANSCANADA PIPELINES LIMITED, TRANSCANADA ENERGY LTD. AND TRANSCANADA GAS SERVICES INC. MUST FILE PROOF OF REJECTION DAMAGES CLAIM

THIS COURT, having entered on May 27, 2004 that certain "Order" granting the Motion of the Debtors seeking authority to reject certain executory contracts contained within the Purchase and Sale Agreement (Margin) dated October 10, 2001, entered into among Mirant Americas Energy Marketing Investments, Inc., and Transcanada Pipelines Limited, Transcanada Energy Ltd. and Transcanada Gas Services, Inc. (collectively, the "TransCanada Entities"); and it appearing that the deadline by which TransCanada must file its proof of claim against the Debtors arising from the rejection of the Contracts is June 28, 2004 (the "Filing Deadline"); and it further appearing that the Debtors and the TransCanada Entities have agreed that the Filing Deadline should be extended ^{*} as set forth herein; and it appearing that the Court has jurisdiction over this matter; and it appearing that due notice of the Motion has been provided, and that no


other or further notice need be provided; upon all of the proceedings had before the Court; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor,
